Make a day of it

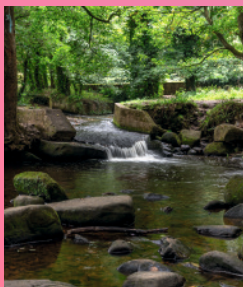

- **Make it Live** – The Live Room is a Saltaire institution and a great place to enjoy the very best live folk, roots and acoustic music.
- **Social Spots** – Independent cafés, bars and restaurants, full of character and style will take you from day to evening. Check out Gordon Terrace in Saltaire, Bingley town centre and Baildon for a great night out.
- **Curry Capital** – Enjoy a great curry in Shipley, Bingley or Baildon, home to local favourites, including the award-winning Aagrah in Shipley, established in 1977.

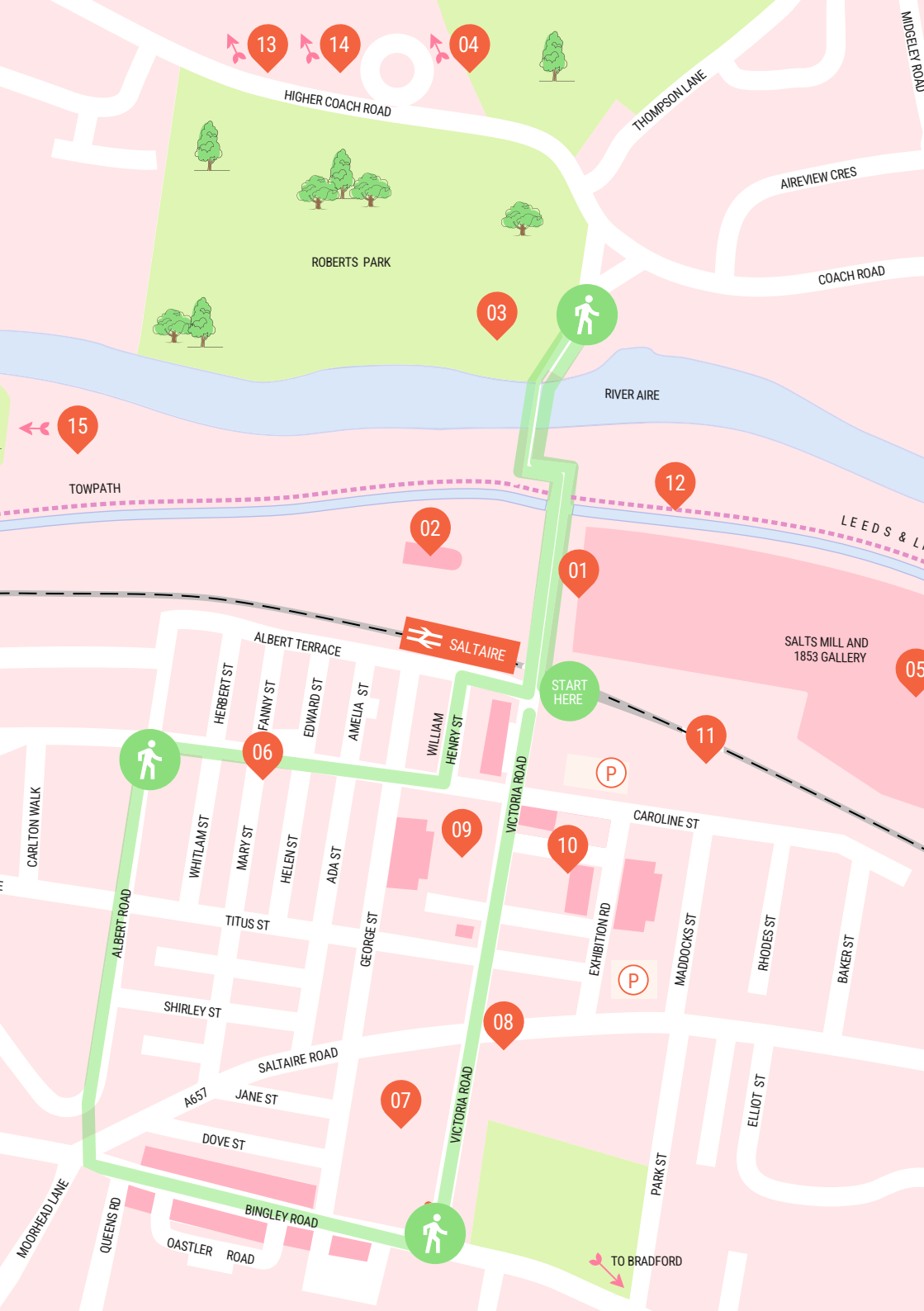


A bit further out

Wander into Saltaire Village Heritage Trail

The Saltaire Heritage Trail provides a glimpse into Saltaire's past. Sir Titus Salt envisioned relocating his business to a greenfield site to escape Bradford's overcrowded, unhealthy conditions. Architects Lockwood & Mawson designed the village grid layout, and positioned the mill to ensure westerly winds would blow smoke away from the village. The mill is separated from housing by allotments where workers grew food. This zoning approach became a model for other company towns.

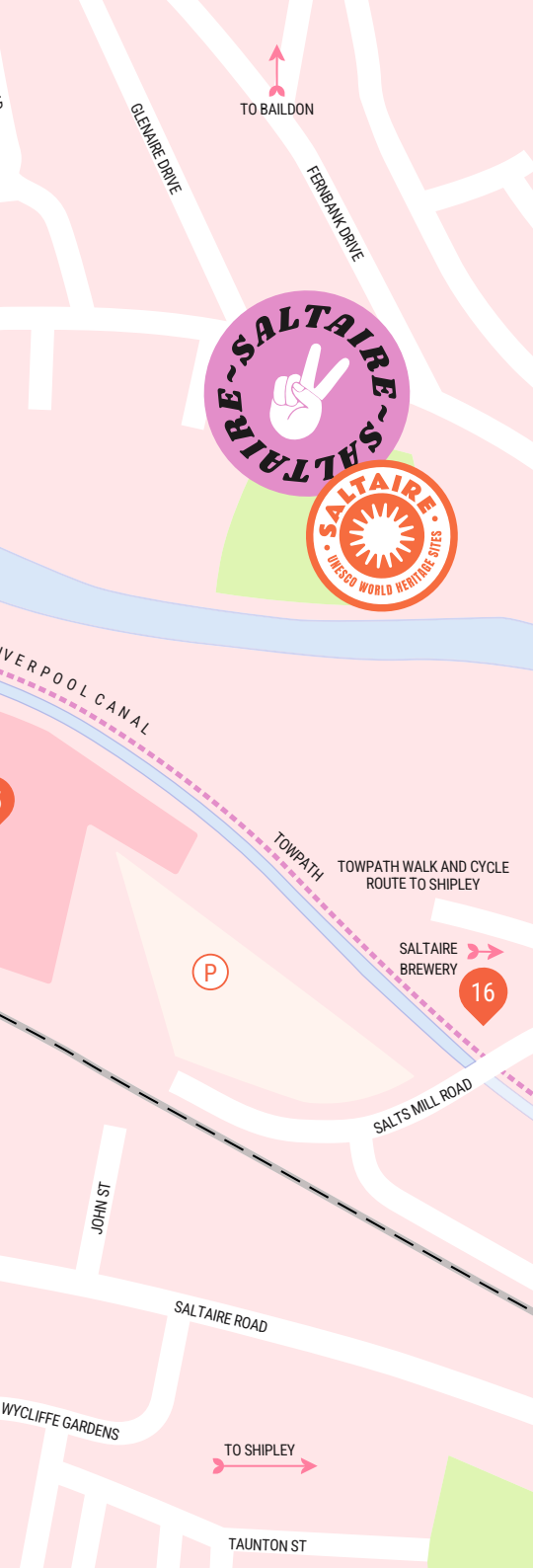

Salts Mill, a 19th-century textile mill, features shops, galleries, dining, and an extensive David Hockney collection.

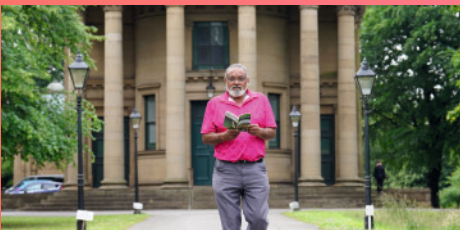

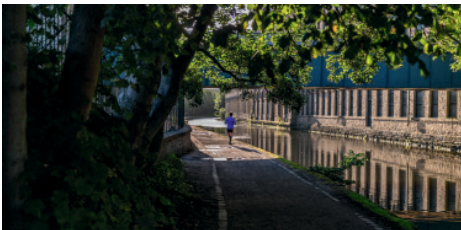

Saltaire is easily accessible by local rail and bus routes. Parking is available at Exhibition Road, Caroline Street, and Salts Mill (via Shipley, postcode BD17 7EF). There is a Clean Air Zone in Bradford, with no charges for passenger cars.
